



Subject: Approval for Concorde Battery RG-35AXC

Models: Navion, A, B, D, E, F, G, H

The Concorde RG-35AXC is the only current battery we have approved as a replacement to previous 12VDC batteries used in production Navion aircraft. FAA approval was received on March 12, 2005 and has been added to our Navion type design. A proposed change has been submitted to the FAA certification office to remove the reference to all batteries in their entirety from the Navion type certificate. The Navion parts manual and/or documentation such as this will be the only reference for approved batteries going forward.

All other drawing callouts for the installation must be adhered to including the original mounting and/or box if equipped. Any electrical wiring deviations must be done I.A.W. AC43.13 and any structural deviations must comply with the Navion Structural Repair Manual or receive separate FAA approval.
